INFORMATION FOR FAMILIES

SAPSASA ONKAPARINGA SOUTH DISTRICT SOFTBALL TEAMS (BOYS – GIRLS)

1. STATE SOFTBALL CARNIVALS

The ONKAPARINGA DISTRICTS (combined North and South) Softball Teams will play in the SAPSASA State Softball Carnival (Boys and Girls Competitions) at Barratt Reserve, corner Military and West Beach Roads, West Beach. Further written information will be given to the families of selected athletes.

2. DATES

2.1. The 2017 State Softball Carnival is from Monday 3 April to Friday 7 April (5 school days).

2.2. The Carnival clashes with the Districts Schools Cross-Country Event on 6 April. Athletes selected to compete in both events will be permitted to do so, as negotiated by families with Softball Coaches

3. SELECTION AND TRAINING TRIALS (no cost)

3.1. Trials each Tuesday from 28 February to 28 March. Teams will be selected on 14 March.

3.2. Boys Coach/Manager: Alexander Gaedt (Teacher – Huntfield Heights Primary School).

Girls Coach/Manager: Gab Martin (Teacher – Hackham East Primary School).

3.3. All athletes at trials must be available for the SAPSASA State Softball Carnival (if selected).

3.4. Athletes must dress for Softball training. Equipment supplied, or players may use their own. No jewellery is to be worn.

3.5. Selection is based on behaviour, co-operation, effort, ability and team-work (as determined by the Coaches).

3.6. Priority is given to Year 7's ahead of Year 6's. Year 6 athletes will be selected before year 7 athletes if, in the opinion of the Coach, they have more ability.

3.7. Year 5's that meet the criteria (born during 2007 or earlier) may only be selected if there are insufficient players in Year 7 and Year 6; and if the Sapsasa Primary School Sport Manager gives approval.

4. TEAMS

4.1. Squads of up to 11 boys and 11 girls will be selected to represent the District.

4.2. Squads will be chosen from athletes from Sapsasa Onkaparinga North and South Districts affiliated schools.

4.3. As much as practicable, players will have equal playing time over the week.

5. CARNIVAL FEES

5.1. The cost for a selected player is \$100 (or \$75 if the athlete family has a School Card).

5.2. Athletes who are later selected this year in a State Carnival Team (soccer, netball, football, hockey, tennis, cricket) will receive a fee reduction of \$25 in these teams.

5.3. Fees cover the levy by SAPSASA for running the Carnival, equipment and clothing hire, and other costs associated with team participation.

6. PARENT INVOLVEMENT AND ASSISTANCE

Parent assistance is welcomed. (equipment, umpiring, scoring, etc.) Please volunteer to help!

7. SOFTBALL CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

7.1. Team colours: Royal Blue and Gold.

7.2. Selected players will be provided with a uniform shirt ON LOAN only. These are to be returned to a team official after the last match of the Carnival.

7.3. Players will receive (to keep) uniform socks, shorts/skorts and cap. The team uniform must be visibly worn at all times during the Carnival. Players will need shin guards.

7.4. The team will be supplied with catcher's protective gear, bats, bases, gloves and helmets.

8. TRANSPORT OF ATHLETES TO VENUE

Private transport needs to be arranged by parents amongst themselves (with the assistance of the Team Managers and Coaches), so that players can go to and return from their matches at the required times.

9. STATE CARNIVAL COMPETITION

There are no finals. Final positions are based on round robin results. Athletes are expected to be good sports, behave well, play for enjoyment, and to show friendliness and respect.
