Dear Students, Staff, Parents and Caregivers,

On Tuesday of this week, our regular Out of School Hours Committee meeting was held and a range of issues raised and discussed. Outlined below is an overview of what was shared.

- Did you know ? Parents of students who are identified as School Card Holders can access both Before and After School Care and Vacation Care at an extremely low rate – subsidised by the Government. See Melissa at OSHC or phone 1300 105 343.
- Vacation Care can only operate if there are 20 bookings each day during any Vacation period. For the upcoming term 1 holidays it is essential that this be realised or no Vacation Care will be offered. If you wish to access Vacation Care for this holiday or any future holiday period please book NOW.
- Parents will be notified well in advance of our term 1 holidays if VAC Care is not offered. Please book NOW.
- If Vacation Care is not available for term 1, this does not mean that Vacation Care will not be offered later in the year. Please book NOW.
- If Vacation Care is not available due to a lack of bookings, Camp Australia will notify parents of other local Vacation Care options.
- Special thanks to Melissa Edlington, OSHC Director, who has volunteered her time at our upcoming Sports Day, volunteering with our Fundraising Committee. Melissa is keen to answer any questions about OSHC/VAC Care at our school.
- All Camp Australia staff are offered Training and Development - for example focusing on students who may be on the Autism Spectrum.
- Camp Australia was recently sold but according to Regional Director Melissa Coad this has had no impact on its operations.
- Camp Australia experienced some glitches with IT bookings in January but this is now resolved.
- All students with complex needs have Guidance support plans.
- Camp Australia has improved the staff/student ratio from 1 staff member to 15 students to one to eleven.

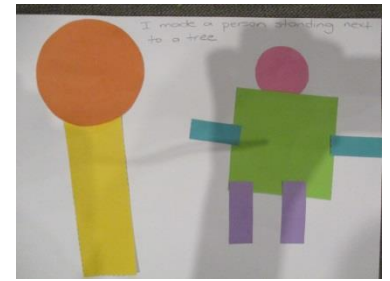
CONGRATULATIONS JOHN IRWIN

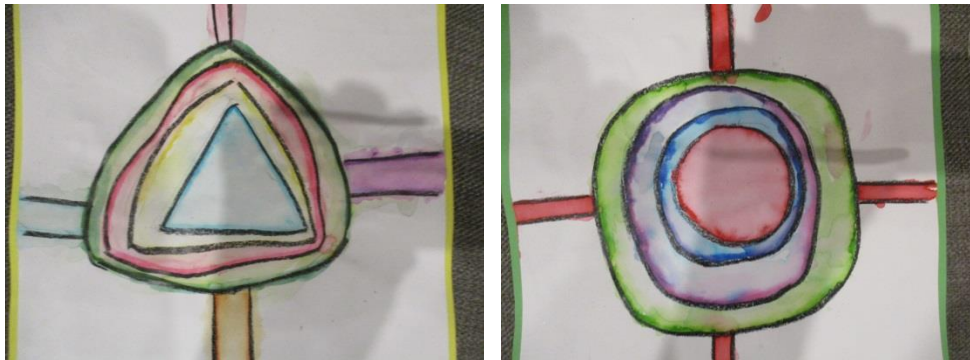
Shaping up in Term 1
