It's coming to the end of term 2 and we would like to share with you some of the experiences we've had throughout the term. The theme has been 'Sustainability' and we have been learning about growing seeds, recycling and we've enjoyed doing lots of fun activities. We have learnt about the life cycle of a seed and what it needs to grow. We planted some tomato, basil, parsley, chives and mixed lettuce seeds. We also planted broad beans in clear cups so we could see them grow.



The three R's – reduce, reuse and recycle have been the focus and we have created a poster of things that we can recycle and we also made a diorama of an animal environment using recycled materials and talked about the impact littering has on the environment with a science experiment.



A parent has kindly donated some food waste recycling bins and also some spider plants that she had planted in used coffee cups.



The children have also enjoyed cooking this term and their favourite thing was the carrot cake. YUM!! They liked it so much we cooked it twice! The recipes are taken for the Camp Australia Healthy Eating Cook Book. The children are given a variety of food choices to meet their nutritional requirements for a healthy body and mind.
