This week we were honoured to have our school's writing improvement story filmed by our department for the Australian Literacy and English Conference which will be held in July. On Monday students were interviewed about the processes that they have used to improve their writing and how they used individual writing goals to focus on improving their writing.

Teachers spoke about how they have used the writing moderation tool to reflect their teaching which has led to a growth in their understanding in the elements of writing. Teachers have also used the writing assessments to set goals with students and explicitly teach the skills so that students



could achieve their writing goals to strengthen their writing. The high expectations in writing across our whole school means that our students are now eagerly looking forward to their next writing assessment so that they see their growth. It also

means that our students are now more engaged and enjoy writing each day.

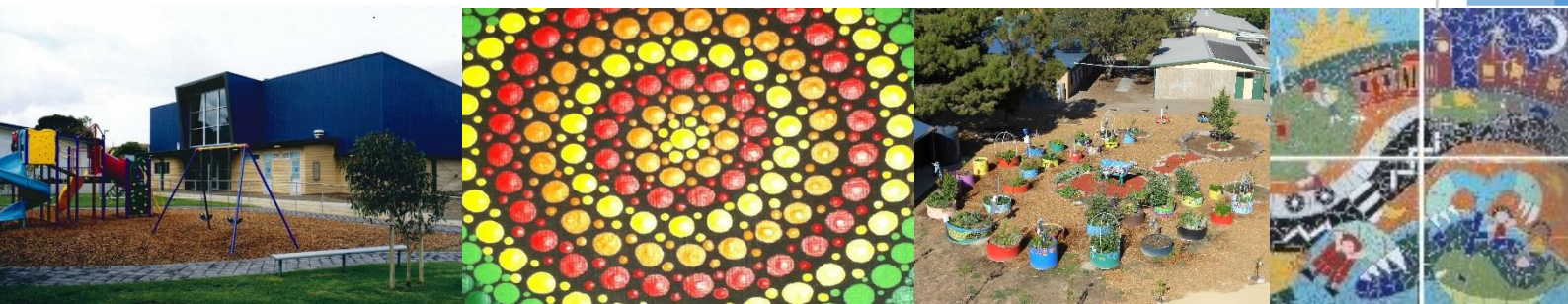


The Wonder of Neurodiversity

There are currently 2 options available

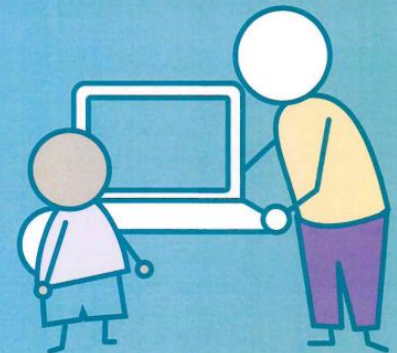
- wireless internet access from the Department for Education through the Student Home Internet Program
